- d. TOEFL Computer based minimum test score 197
- e. TOEIC (Test of English for International Communication) Minimum test scores: Listening 350. Reading 300. Speaking: 160. Writing 140

If this address does not link, please go to www.casa.gov.au. Then go to the "Services" button. Click here and look for the Aviation Medical button and find "Search for a Medical Examiner") or with an approved doctor after arrival in Australia. Note: wherever possible we recommend that you complete your Class 1 Aviation Medical before departure to Australia

4. Age

You must be 18 years of age by the time you commence training with Australian National Airline College.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

APPLICATION FEE FOR COURSES

Australian National Airline College charges overseas applicants a \$1500 course application fee. This is a non-refundable fee, however we will refund 50% of the fee within 30 days of receipt of the required evidence outlined below, if either of the following situations occur:

- i. You apply for a student visa and your application is rejected and you supply us with evidence that your application was rejected (i.e a copy of the rejection letter from the Australian Embassy/High Commission/Consulate)
- ii. You apply for your CASA Aviation medical off shore (outside of Australia) and fail the medical and you provide evidence to us that to this effect (i.e in the form of an official letter from the CASA designated medical examiner)



TUITION FEES

- i. Tuition fees are charged in arrears and do not include CASA exam fees, Air Services Charges, Landing Fees or CASA Licence issue fees.
- ii. Course fees are subject to change
- iii. Due date: Tuition fees for all courses must be paid within one week **after** our invoice is issued to you. Failure to pay the invoice by the due date may result in a late fee of 2% per week being charged, suspension of training and possible loss of place on your course.

FEE REFUND

Due to the fact that no monies are paid in advance a refund policy is not required.

There would only be a refund on payments made for services not supplied and this would be refunded within 21 days of receipt of a "Request for refund of services" form.

ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS & RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL)

Australian National Airline College offers courses at different levels. Different academic qualifications are required for entry to each level. ATTENDANCE/ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

Regular attendance is a requirement for all students. All overseas students must attend a minimum of 80% of classes to qualify for their licence/certificate/diploma (as applicable) and to meet student visa regulations. If students do not make satisfactory academic progress they may not be allowed to continue training or to re-enrol.
